About us

Reepham Tennis Club was formed in 2011 with grants from Sport England's Inspired Facilities fund and Broadland District Council's Community Grant. It is run by a small committee of volunteers. We are funded through membership fees alone and the courts are located at Stimpsons Piece, Reepham. We aim to be a friendly, safe and inclusive club who welcome all within the community regardless of ability.

Where we are

We are located at Stimpson's Piece, off Station Road in Reepham. Driving out of Reepham on Station Road turn left just before the Methodist Chapel (about 200m from V's cafe) and continue down Kerdiston Road past Smugglers Lane and the Scout's hut. Just after the Scout's hut is a shingle car park in trees on the right-hand side. The courts are just behind.

Court booking & access

The courts are open 8.00am–11.00 pm every day. Peak times are 5.00pm–11.00pm, Monday–Friday and all day at weekends. During these times Members only are allowed on courts. A court booking system is available on our website (clubspark.lta.org.uk/ReephamTennisClub/Booking). This enables Members to book a court up to two weeks in advance. Members should only book for a maximum 2 hours per booking during peak times. Courts are block booked for regular sessions (matches, coaching etc.) Currently these are as follows:

Tuesday	4.30pm–6.30pm	Junior Coaching
Tuesday	6.30pm–9.00pm	Club Night – all welcome
Thursday	6.30pm–9.00pm	Mens Team practice/Matches
Sunday	10.30am–12.30pm	Club Morning - all welcome

Pay & Play

This is available Monday–Friday, 10.00am–3.00pm.

It costs £10.00 per hour for one court plus a refundable deposit of £10.00 for the key. The maximum number of players allowed on the court is 4. (If 4 people play this works out at £2.50 each.)

Keys should be collected from the Club's Liaison Officer and the fee and deposit paid. Arrangements should be made to return the keys and collect the deposit. You must sign in as you pick the keys up for insurance purposes.

Pay & Play users are able to book a court up to 48 hours in advance by calling 07766 087440 or emailing payandplay@reephamtennisclub.co.uk. We will endeavour to confirm any Pay & Play booking requests within 24 hours. We will also give details of where to collect the keys and pay the fee.

Pay & Play users have access to the courts only and not the clubhouse.

General

Please remember to lock the courts as you leave. Please take care of the courts, clubhouse and equipment. No food or drink on courts please, plastic water bottles only. We would encourage all users to wear appropriate tennis clothes and shoes.

Insurance

The Club has public liability insurance. Members are advised that this does not cover personal injury incurred whilst playing tennis. Members are advised not to play in any adverse weather conditions.

Club Code of Conduct

We aim to be an inclusive club – all Members and visitors must respect each other regardless of age & ability.

We aim to be a family friendly club – appropriate language should be used at all times.

We aim to keep our fees as low as possible – please respect the equipment and wear appropriate shoes. No food or drink on court (except plastic water bottles). Apart from occasional guests (see membership rules) only Members and Pay & Play users should be on court.

We aim to be a safe club – no smoking, no consumption of alcohol or drugs of any kind is permitted. If sharing the courts please be aware of the safety of others. No dogs allowed on the courts.

We run the club on the basis of honesty and mutual trust. Please respect this.

Please lock the clubhouse and courts if you are the last one to leave.
